Appeal #2020-1 MV Mr. Karl Stanley is appealing the assessment for his 1987 Ford F150 Regular Cab, 2 Wheel Drive. Mr. Stanley said that the value of the truck should be \$500. Mr. Brown informed Mr. Stanley that he had the option of putting Antique Plates on the vehicle. Mr. Brown stated that Mr. Stanley had been told to put an antique plate on the vehicle when he appeared before the Board in a previous year. Mr. Brown reminded him that this would automatically put a \$500 assessment on the Ford yearly. The other option is to file yearly the Affidavit for Antique, Rare or Special Interest Motor Vehicles. If the affidavit is not filed, the vehicle reverts to the NADA value. Mr. Stanley gave the Assessor his affidavit for the 2021 Grand List.

Appeal #2020-2 MV Mr. David Yapchanyk is appealing the assessment of his 2017 Four Model DO190MDS-17-G boat trailer. Mr. Yapchanyk stated that the value of the trailer should be \$1,600. Mr. Brown stated that the Assessor agreed that there was a mistake in the assessment value. Mr. Yapchanyk asked if they could do anything about the year before. Mr. Brown replied that no they could not, only the present.

Discussion and possible action on appellants:

Appeal #2020-1 MV Mr. Stanley is requesting his assessment on 1987 Ford 150 be \$500. The Assessor confirmed that Mr. Stanley did not file an Affidavit for the 2020 Grand List.

A motion was made for no change by Mr. Brown, second by Mr. Button. All in favor, aye. Motion carries.

Appeal #2020-2 MV Mr. Yapchanyk is requesting his value be corrected to \$1,600 on his 2017 Four Model DO190MOS-17-G boat trailer. A motion was made by Mr. Button to put the appraised value to \$1,600 with an assessment of \$1,120, second by Mr. Marzec. All in favor, aye. Motion carries.

Discussion and Possible action on 2022 Schedule of Meeting Dates.
