

Board of Warden and Burgesses  
Special Meeting  
May 17, 2018

Warden Geer called the Special Meeting to order at 3:30pm at the Griswold Town Hall, Selectman's Conference Room, Second Floor.

Burgess Sharkey made motion to have Laurie Sorder as acting secretary, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Burgess Sorder. All in favor, aye. Motion carries.

Warden Geer opened the meeting up for discussion.

Chuck Woods is present to discuss the concerns about alcohol and tables on the sidewalk the night of the Nite Lite Parade. Burgess Sorder gave a brief summary of how this came about. There was discussion about the Pub having a permit for a patio, the board having no knowledge of this. She called the Liquor Commission and was told that they do have a patio permit. The permit would not have been given without the town approval. There was a diagram that Burgess Sorder referred to.

Mr. Woods stated that there have been barricades ordered for seating. There was discussion on barricades that will go up. Mr. Woods would like Jewett City be like Mystic, Killingly.

Burgess Sorder noted that there is an ordinance about no drinking on public streets. First Selectman Babbitt read "where permission has been granted".

Discussion followed with Mr. Woods regarding signage, bartenders (knowing what can and cannot do) etc.

Burgess Sorder asked about the diagram and one table down by Dean's.

Warden Geer suggested not having tables out until the barricades are in.

Burgess Sharkey made motion to adjourn, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Burgess Sorder. All in favor, aye. Motion carries
