

**Town of Griswold
Ethics Commission Meeting
April 8, 2021
via Teleconference**

The April 8, 2021 meeting of the Griswold Ethics Commission was called to order at 7 pm by Chairman Mark S. Sulik. The roll was called and the following Commission members were in attendance:

I. Approval of Minutes:

The Chairman called for corrections or additions to the minutes of the January 7, 2021 meeting. Hearing none, a motion to accept the minutes was made by Kathy Petersen and seconded by Joseph D'Errico. All were in favor and the motion carried.

II. Old Business:

1. Commission vacancy/ Need for Reappointment:

2. Review of Code of Ethics:

These, along with the current code, were reviewed by Elizabeth Scannell and Kathy Petersen. There were no new laws that would impact our Code of Ethics. It is our recommendation that no changes are need to our Code of Ethics at this time. A motion to accept this recommendation was made by Joseph D'Errico and seconded by Kathy Petersen. All were in favor and the motion carried. The Secretary will notify the Board of Selectmen and Town Clerk.

Having no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Jackie Jamrock and seconded by Joseph D'Errico. All were in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 pm.
