Glasgo Water Pollution Control Authority Meeting Minutes

The meeting of the Glasgo Water Pollution Control Authority was called to order at 6:03 pm by Chester Greczkowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance was said. Those in attendance were Chester Greczkowski Jr., Elinor Rix Greczkowski, Mark Manuzzi and Monique Manuzzi

The recorder did not work due to a malfunction, so the minutes are going by the secretary's written minutes.

Chester and Monique are looking into having the broken pump fixed as we are only running on one right now. Have made some phone calls and just waiting for someone to come look and give us an estimate. Hungerford Pump Service sent a letter stating there will be an increase starting September 1, 2021. Monique needs to call and change billing to her address and no longer Paul Brycki.

One pump tank cover needs to be replaced before winter and needs to be pumped. Abrahamson septic came out and looked at the cover and will send me an estimate on the cover and pumping. Mark motioned to approve and Monique second the motion.

Chester let us know he had to cut the chain because no keys for the lock are to be found. He will replace with a new combo lock. He will purchase the locks and we on the committee will each have a key and Todd will also have one. The gate needs to be realigned as well. Mark motioned and Ellie second the motion.

The alarm and light on the panel are still not working so Monique is going to call prime electric to see if they can come out and look at it and give an estimate to fix.

Mark asked about the manhole cover that was tarred over on 201. This was supposed to be taken care of and nothing has been done yet. Monique to email Todd and ask.

Monique will also let Todd know the leach field on the hill needs to be mowed so the septic truck can get up there to pump. It is very overgrown, and the covers are covered in weeds with roots that need to be cut.

A motion was made by Chester to adjourn the meeting and seconded by Mark; all agreed; no one opposed. The meeting adjourned at 6:23 pm.
