

The following procedure for Pachaug Pond Property Owners, who desire to work on their sub-aqueous property, has been issued by the Connecticut Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP).

Guidance for property owners who propose to do work on shorefront or submerged lands while Pachaug Lake is drawn down for dam repair fall 2021 to spring 2022.

1. Property owners must determine the extent of their own property boundary (e.g. ends at water line or extends into lake).
2. Property owners must determine if any proposed work will be conducted on others' property, including DEEP property and/or if DEEP property will be utilized to conduct work.
3. If the proposed work is not conducted on DEEP property and/or DEEP property will not be utilized to conduct work, the property owner should contact the Griswold Inland Wetlands Agency for permitting requirements.
4. No work may be conducted on DEEP property nor can DEEP property be utilized to conduct work.
5. Property owners may conduct work once all applicable licenses/permits have been granted.
