III. Aquifer Protection Agency

1. Call to Order

Vice Chair Robert Parrett called this regular meeting of the Aquifer Protection Agency to order on June 21, 2012 at 7:50 p.m.

2. Roll Call & Determination of Quorum

R. Parrette appointed G. Serdechny to sit for J. Waitte, L. Churchill to sit for C. Kinnie and P. Merrill to sit for L. Laidley. There was a quorum for this regular meeting.

3. Matters Presented for Discussion

C. Fontneau stated that the three possible registrants have been sent a letter and a map showing the aquifer protection area and if they register by August 16, 2012, the fee will be waived if they send the forms on time. There was discussion of this matter.

R. Parrette asked if there were concerns from the Public.

Joel Francouer stated that the original mapping of the aquifer overlay area did not include Route 12 and Clayville Pond but included the old Triangle Property. He stated that because the Triangle property on the lake has to be cleaned up the state took that area out of the overlay and moved it to route 12 and clayville pond. He stated that no DEEP agent or uncase health representative have done any testing on his property. He stated that he has sent numerous correspondence to DEEP and Uncas Health and he has had no response. He stated that all the text well are behind Pam's Barber shop on route 201. He stated that if you go on line to the Jewett City water company through the Hazardville Water, LLC and Avery and Dewey corporation and the regulatory commission's yearly reporting they spent minimal money on this mapping and picked an area that they assumed was not polluted and made the wetlands commission accept this mapping. He stated that he gave a copy of the Special 'Act of the Jewett City Water Company and this company can be held liable for the properties that are in this aquifer overlay area. There was discussion of this matter including that the commission requested that the area not be so large and that the state had the final say and getting the testing and maps.

4. Adjournment

R. Parrette asked for a motion to adjourn. S. Stadnicki made a motion to adjourn. D. Rubino seconded the motion. All were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
