III. Aquifer Protection Agency

1. Call to Order

Chairman Courtland Kinnie called this regular meeting of the Aquifer Protection Agency to order on November 19, 2014 at 8:55 p.m.

C. Kinnie appointed G. Serdechny to sit for D. Rubino's vacancy. L. Churchill to sit for J. Waitte and P. Merrill to sit for G. Norman. There was a quorum for this regular meeting.

3. Matters Presented for Discussion

A. Discussion of and updates from DEEP regarding one outstanding registrant including complaints from neighbors received by DEEP Aquifer Protection Agency Program (APA Program) and any updates from Town attorney and/or registrant's attorney.

R. Parrette asked about the handouts for Bituminous Concrete. S. Stadnicki stated that she asked for this information about hazardous materials and what asphalt was. There was discussion of this matter. C. Kinnie stated that the members should review this material because there will eventually be a registration to ask the right questions. He thanked S. Stadnicki and D. Szall for the information.

C. Kinnie stated that there is a conference call with Kim Czapl of DEEP with Mario and the First Selectman on Tuesday November 25 at 10 am and that any members can attend this conference call. There was discussion of this matter.
