APPROVED MINUTES

- 1. Call to Order/Roll Call** – The meeting was first opened by the Borough Warden, John Connelly at 3:02 PM followed by the pledge of allegiance. First Selectman, Philip Anthony, then opened the meeting for the Board of Selectmen.

- 2. New Business**

- a. Discussion on parking availability on Ashland Street** – Todd Babbitt mentioned the suggestion is to place lines for six parking spaces on Ashland Street starting at Hill Street down to the park entrance and to line seven additional spots along the road starting beyond the entrance to the nurses building. T. Babbitt suggested implementing all parking spaces at one time and not phasing them. He also commented the parking time will be limited to 8 AM – 5 PM, during normal business hours, and signs should be erected to notice that. It was mentioned by T. Sharkey and S. Mikutel that we do want to allow parking there beyond 5 PM or on the weekend if there is an event going on at the park. It was mentioned it will not be noted on the signs that parking will be allowed during certain events, but it will not be enforced by the Resident Trooper if there is a special event going on. People do park there now, but by lining the spaces, more parking will be made available. A formal motion was made by the Borough to initiate a letter to Todd Babbitt to move forward with the plan for additional parking spaces. P. Anthony commented that he will send a letter on behalf of the Board of Selectmen supporting the motion made by the Borough.

Brief discussion ensued about residents parking in the parking lot at the nurses building. P. Anthony commented he has spoke to the staff in charge at the nurse's building and if there is a problem they will contact him. There was an issue before, but as of late it has not been an issue. It was also briefly discussed about the emergency trucks having access on Carly Ave. Mr. Connelly also mentioned the idea of making Pulaski Street and Tracy Ave. into one way streets.

3. Adjournment
