#### I. REGULAR MEETING (7:30 P.M.)

1. **Call to Order:** Chairman Kinnie called the regular meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.
2. **Roll Call & Determination of a Quorum:** Present were regular members Kinnie, Laidley, Waitte, and Stadnicki and alternate member Serdechney who Chairman Kinnie seated for absent regular member Parette. A quorum was present.
3. **Applications:** There were none
4. **Additional Business (new applications):** There were none
5. **Reports from the Enforcement Officer:** WEO Zvingilas reported briefly on the status of a wetlands permit on Mackin Road.
6. **Old Business:** There was no pending old business.
- 6A. Continued Review of Possible Changes to IWWCC Regulations Based on CTDEP Model Regulations. The Chairman reported briefly on the progress made by at a regulation subcommittee meeting preceding the regular meeting attended by Kinnie, Stadnicki, Laidley, and Planner Fontneau. This subcommittee had discussed sections 11 to 20 of the proposed integration into the CTDEP model regulations and suggested a few minor changes which, along with catching up with earlier changes suggested in January, the Planner would attempt to have a complete edited copy of the proposed wetlands regulations based on the model regulations to send to members in the March agenda package. With little additional discussion, the members present agreed with this approach. Chairman Kinnie thanked the regulation subcommittee for their extra work in this effort.

  - C. Request for Comments on the US ACOE Reissuance with some amendments of the Connecticut General Permit for minimal-impact activities within waters of the US. Chairman Kinnie had some brief questions about the excerpts of this documents that Planner had provided members. This General Permit renewal with a few modifications would affect very few, larger projects in Griswold over a long period of time. Most projects are and have been under the size threshold where these General Permit requirements would be triggered.
